

How to use CSS in the column editor:

The completion statuses are typically stored in lowercase in the database. To show the text case consistently the same way in a report, you can utilize CSS (Cascading Style Sheets) and make the text in a column all lowercase, uppercase, or mixed case by capitalizing each word.

This is an example using the Status field to capitalize each word of the Status's value. To do this, **text-transform: capitalize** was entered in the 'Additional CSS' field.
